- March 4th Joint Rule 5-13 in effect
- March 8th Last day for smoke out in 2nd house
- March 9th Last day for a bill or joint resolution to pass both houses
- March 10th -12th Reserved for concurrences and conference committees
- March 29th Last day of Session – reserved for consideration of gubernatorial vetoes
