The Foundation was established to promote professionalism in adherence to the letter and spirit of the Code of Ethics of the national Association of REALTORS® and for such other related purposes encouraging real estate education, and for other worthy projects.

Incorporated under South Dakota law, the tax exempt Foundation provides an excellent vehicle for REALTORS® and friends of the real estate industry, through tax deductible contributions, to support these worthy goals.

Memorial contributions to the Foundation are a fitting way of honoring deceased members of the South Dakota Association of REALTORS®, especially those members who were long standing in their support of REALTOR® ideals.

Gifts

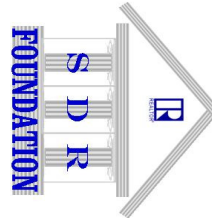
